

Renate W. Chasman Scholarship for Women 2010 Competition

About the Scholarship

Sponsored by Brookhaven Women in Science of Brookhaven National Laboratory (BNL), the Renate W. Chasman Scholarship encourages women to pursue a career in the natural sciences, engineering, or mathematics. The award honors the late Renate Chasman, a noted woman physicist at BNL. A one-time award of \$2,000 will be made directly to the recipient, to be applied towards expenses associated with an academic program pursued on a half time or greater basis.

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to receive this award you must be:

- A "re-entry" woman - one who has returned to school to pursue her education following an interruption.
- A citizen of the United States or a permanent resident alien.
- A resident of Long Island in New York State (i.e. Nassau County, Suffolk County, Brooklyn, or Queens).
- Accepted for credit into a degree-oriented program in the natural sciences (e.g., chemistry, physics, biology), engineering, or mathematics, at an accredited educational institution.
- Entering the junior or senior undergraduate, or first-year graduate level.

Instructions to Applicants

- Fill out this form completely; do not substitute a resume for any of the information requested. You may insert an extra page if additional space is required.
- **By April 1, 2010**, send this form, together with a statement of career goals, transcripts for all schools attended since high school (photocopies are acceptable), two professional letters of reference, and a stamped, self-addressed envelope to **Chasman Scholarship, P.O. Box 183, Upton, NY, 11973**. *All of these items must be submitted and the application form must be signed for you to be considered for the award.*
- Brookhaven Women in Science reserves the right to request further information during the selection process. **This will include the social security number or alien registration number of the winning applicant.**
- The scholarship will be awarded prior to the fall 2010 term and after proof of fall enrollment is provided.
