SECURITY CHANGES FOR VISITORS TO THE VIENNA INTERNATIONAL CENTER

This year, on arriving at the Vienna International Center (VIC), visitors will confront changes to the security policies and access procedures. These changes were implemented on January 1st to bring the VIC into alignment with security protocols present at all UN facilities.

Security has been increased worldwide partially in response to the 2003 attack on UN headquarters in Iraq and the 2007 attack on the UN library in Algiers.

Consultants and conference participants now access the VIC through Gate 1 only (the main gate on Wagramer Strasse adjacent to the VIC U-Bahn stop). A new security perimeter has been established around this entrance, and visitors must first pass through an x-ray screening booth before proceeding through revolving doors into the main entrance area. This screening procedure is performed on all visitors every time they enter the VIC.

Temporary badges are picked up at the Visitors' Center, located within the main entrance area of Gate 1. These badges do not have RF chips in them, so they must be displayed to the UN guards to gain entrance to the VIC. New sliding security doors have also been installed at the exit to Gate 1. To exit, visitors must display their temporary badges to the guard who will then open the doors to let them out.

The VIC Security Office wishes to convey that improving safety and security at the VIC is in everyone's interest and thanks us for our understanding and support.
