McTague Called to the Capital

John McTague, chairman of the National Synchrotron Light Source Department, has been plucked from the staff at BNL to become the new deputy director of the Office of Science and Technology Policy. He started his new job last week and will be commuting back and forth between BNL and Washington, D.C. until the end of this month, when he will go to Washington full-time.

In a recent interview, McTague referred to his new job as the kind of offer he could not turn down. "It's like being drafted into the Army," he said. "When you are asked to serve, you go."

The Office of Science and Technology Policy (OSTP) is an executive agency, under the President. The federal government's research and development budget is \$45 billion. OSTP serves to evaluate the government's effort in R&D and to advise the President on science and technological matters.

McTague has been at Brookhaven for a year and a half, although his association with the Laboratory goes back to 1974, when he began the first of a series of guest and research collaborator appointments in the Physics Department. Before coming full-time to BNL, he was a professor of chemistry at the University of California at Los Angeles. McTague is a physical chemist, with extensive experience in neutron scattering and x-ray scattering research.

Commenting on his year and a half at BNL, McTague said, "It's been an exciting time at the NSLS. The VUV ring has become the brightest in the world, and there has been an extensive commissioning effort on the X-ray ring. The first x-ray beam lines are expected to be hooked up in the next two months. I have been impressed by the broad response of the scientific community to the Light Source and even more impressed by the dedication, hard work and enthusiasm of the NSLS staff. I'm going to miss them all."

Until a replacement for McTague is found, Associate Director Martin Blume will act as NSLS chairman.

Congressional Assurances

Long Island Congressman William Carney came to the Laboratory on November 7 to hold a press conference. He reported on Congressional thinking about the termination of the CBA project and its impact on BNL.

Mr. Carney stated that "I have received the assurance of the House Committee on Appropriations that it will not permit the redistributing of Colliding Beam Accelerator funds for FY 84 without guarantees from the U. S. Department of Energy that the CBA facilities and project staff will be put to constructive use in physics research. The House Committee on Science and Technology also concurs with this position."

Specifically, Carney had received written assurances from Congressman Tom Bevill, chairman of the Subcommittee on Energy and Water Development of the House Committee on Appropriations, that "...the Committee approved the Department of Energy's redirection of CBA funds contingent on the development of a strong technical program at Brookhaven leading to the utilization of the existing CBA facilities."

Similarly, Congressman Don Fuqua, chairman of the House Committee on Science and Technology, indicated

that Congress expects the Energy Department "to prevent any significant negative impacts...on BNL's current staffing levels."

One of the projects proposed to be placed in the CBA tunnel is a heavy ion collider. As a first step in this direction, Brookhaven will begin construction of a tunnel to link the Tandem Van de Graaff with the AGS. This is a two-year \$11 million undertaking, and \$5 million is being programmed for this purpose in the FY 84 budget. (The collider itself would require funding in the neighborhood of \$150-\$200 million, with construction targeted to begin in 1986).

DOE has also allocated \$10 million of high energy physics funds to Brookhaven for research on advanced accelerator development, what is now known as the Superconducting Super Collider. Carney also stated that, in addition, "\$4.3 million will be spent to preserve our \$200 million investment in the CBA...and other monies will be spent to upgrade the AGS, and to conduct heavy ion research."

Final budget figures have not yet been nailed down; in certain areas, Brookhaven and DOE are still discussing the precise amounts to be provided.

DOE Awards to Energy Savers

Energy conservation received its due last month when Secretary of Energy Donald Hodel presented awards for In-House Energy Management at a ceremony in Washington. Of the 12 individuals and organizations singled out for outstanding accomplishment, three were from Brookhaven.

Associate Director Vincent O'Leary, Joseph Rose, Manager of the Engineering Division of Plant Engineering, and David Schweller, Manager of DOE's Brookhaven Area Office, were those so honored.

O'Leary was cited "for leadership and management of a highly efficient energy conservation program to burn alternate liquid fuels in the Laboratory's steam plant in an environmentally safe manner saving approximately 143,000 barrels of fuel oil and \$2 million annually."

Rose was recognized "for individual initiative and effort which resulted in the development of the Alternative

Liquid Fuels Program at the Laboratory."

Schweller received the award for the Best Area Office program. Douglas Miller, the Area Office's Energy Coordinator, accompanied the group to Washington.

In the last ten years, energy conservation surveys and retrofit projects have reduced energy consumption 16% per square foot in DOE buildings. Also, the DOE says the use of petroleum based fuels in its buildings has been reduced by 58%.

At the presentation ceremony, Secretary Hodel said, "I am especially pleased to be participating in a program to recognize DOE achievements in energy conservation. Energy conservation is high on my list of priorities. I believe that energy conservation ought to be viewed by everyone — policy-makers, producers, consumers — as a significantly important energy resource — a set of actions that are cost-effective alternatives to new supply development...."

Enter IR-100 Free

If you have invented something of note at the Lab during the calendar year 1983, you may wish to enter the 1984 IR-100 competition. And the Lab will pay your expenses.

This competition, sponsored by Research & Development magazine, selects the 100 most significant technical products each year. Technical product is defined as "any product, material, process, or system of scientific or technical origin or use."

This is the 22nd year of this competition, and employees have entered in the past at their own expense. To further encourage inventors, BNL has opted to foot the bill.

In 1969, Meyer Steinberg, now head of the Process Sciences Division of DAS, entered the competition and BNL was named a winner. He won for the development of concrete polymer composite material.

William Marcuse, head of the Office of Research and Technology Applications (Bldg. 130, 2-33), has the entry forms and further information. He

points out that all applications must be cleared by the Patent Office and approved by the applicant's department chairman. The deadline for filing is March 1, 1984.

Winners will be honored at an awards banquet at the Museum of Science & Industry in Chicago next September 20. Winning products will be exhibited that day and for the following month at the museum.

AGS on a High

Beam intensity is the name of the game at the AGS. The more protons delivered per second to the experimental targets, the more and better physics results. Over the last year the AGS has increased its delivered beam intensity by 40% while establishing a new record peak intensity of 1.48×10^{13} protons per pulse.

And the Beat Goes On . . .

Sights and sounds compete for an operator's attention in the main control room of the Alternating Gradient Synchrotron (AGS). Digital displays and video screens, the jangle of many telephones and the click of a keyboard — the operator constantly sifts through inputs, subconsciously culling some and consciously responding to others. Underscoring it all is the insistent, consistent, throaty gong that marks the pulse of the AGS.

And the beat goes on, thanks in large measure to the round-the-clock attentions of eight control room operators: Bob Diem, Roy Garcia, Fred Heilemann, Paul Hichborn, Tom Mooney, Paul Sparrow, Bill Taylor and Ray Zaharatos. Of this group, supervisor Sam Wingard says, "We look for someone with a good electronics background and some computer experience, but basically he must learn something totally new, from the equipment to the actual machine operation. And that requires a unique talent. A person must develop a sixth sense to get the feel of things, to be able to diagnose problems."

A nose for diagnosis is particularly important outside of regular working hours. Two operators are always on duty in the main control room. They work as partners in 12-hour shifts, two days on, two days off. When something goes awry, either in the one-half-mile AGS ring, the 1500-foot long Linac or any of six experimental areas, diagnosis must be swift and sure. Swiftmess is critical because valuable experimental time is being lost; sureness is essential so the right course of action can be taken.

"If something breaks after hours, we get thirty minutes to fix it. If we can't handle it, we get help," says Diem. That's when a call-in is necessary. In recent years, areas like the Linac, the pump room, and health physics have eliminated shifts in favor of a rotating list of technicians who are on call should a problem arise.

"Our main priority is to keep the machine running," Diem says. "This is a very complex machine, so if you can say you ran for eight hours without a problem, that's something."

Learning how to run the AGS is largely a matter of on-the-job training. First, says Zaharatos, who is Wingard's second-in-command, "an operator must become familiar with the consoles. Just to find your way around takes about a year." Measuring about 250 square feet, the consoles cover the east, west and north walls of the main control room. The operators do most of their work at the main console against the north wall, but can

also use two smaller consoles along the east and west walls. Surrounded by all this technology, Garcia recalls, "The first six months I just sat here like a sponge. Nobody really knows how long it takes to learn this job because you never stop learning."

And just when an operator has mastered the control panel, something is bound to change. The AGS has just been upgraded to achieve higher design intensities and is now being modified to circulate polarized protons and function with a new RFQ preaccelerator. The operators agree that this continual change of environment keeps the job interesting. Zaharatos says, "It's difficult to get bored or rest on your laurels when you're constantly learning new things." At the same time, of course, the old things must continue to be done. "Sometimes," Garcia says, "it's like spinning plates, trying to keep them all spinning at once."

In short, the operators must be ready for any eventuality. "When something goes wrong, that's when experience comes in," Wingard says. "Some really bizarre things can happen." These things can range from magnet fires, to a racoon strolling down the hallway, to the vagaries of Mother Nature. "Even if the Lab closes early during a snowstorm, we expect the operators to try to come in and keep things going," says Wingard.

To balance their heavy responsibilities, the operators try to keep their moods on the lighter side. A glance at Paul Sparrow's backward clock (coordinated with the counterclockwise circulation of the AGS proton beam) can evoke a chuckle. And a few moments contemplating the tropical fish in their tank on the east wall can restore peace when things are hectic.

But no matter what the situation, when the AGS is going, the sound of its pulse is all pervasive. "Basically I don't hear it," says Diem, "until it goes off or the intensity changes. It doesn't bother me at all. In fact, I like its rhythm. It tells me that everything's going well."

Volunteers Needed

Volunteers are needed to act as control subjects for a study concerned with assessing cytogenetic damage in a population of opioid users. The study population will be patients admitted to Northport Veterans Administration Medical Center (VAMC) for opioid detoxification. One control volunteer will be required for each patient studied from VAMC. The Medical Department specifically requires BNL employees, male, U.S. veterans between the ages of 25 and 40, for control individuals.

Each participant will be asked to donate 10 ml of peripheral blood as well as to complete a short medical history, so that a control may be matched as closely as possible with each patient from VAMC. Ten dollars will be paid to all participants donating blood.

Inside Info

A few weeks ago, the Bulletin reported that **Barbara McClintock**, the 1983 Nobel Prize winner in medicine, had been a guest researcher at BNL. Now it turns out that Brookhaven has also been honored by association with a second 1983 Nobel laureate, **Henry Taube** of Stanford University, winner of the chemistry award. Taube, who was a visiting scientist in the Chemistry Department in 1958 has also been on the department's visiting committee.

While at BNL, Taube worked with senior chemist **Norman Sutin** and former department chairman **Richard Dodson**, who is now retired. They studied electron transfer reactions, in both light and heavy water, to determine whether hydrogen atom transfer was involved. This research, says Sutin, "was closely related to his Nobel Prize winning work." That work identified bridging as an important mechanism for electron transfer between metal centers. Today, Sutin says, "he maintains close contact with our research on inorganic reaction mechanisms. Our inorganic group has enjoyed an ongoing exchange of ideas with him, and he has made many imaginative and insightful contributions to our work."

Another Brookhaven scientist who has been associated with Taube is **Carol Creutz**. Taube was Creutz's thesis advisor at Stanford University from 1966-70. For her thesis, Creutz studied the properties of mixed valence compounds that contain two metal ions which differ by one electron. That electron wants to go back and forth between the two metal centers, and so is like the transients involved in Taube's prize-winning work. Creutz stays in touch with Taube and says, "He is extremely loyal and supportive to all his students and associates."
