- 2. CARE workshop and focus group update
 - A new focus group was established by Dr. Vatsal Bhatt (Sustainable Energy Technologies Department) on "Advancing Bench-Scale Concepts to Market". A first discussion has been set on Feb. 21, noon-1pm at RSB room #1. Kimberley Elcess from TCP office will also attend. Invitation has been sent out to all focus group leaders and other groups/departments of interests.
 - A focus group on "Nanoscience" was proposed by Madhura Som (Ph.D student, SBU/MSE); help is needed to reach out to potential participants and speakers. Vivian suggested to include a senior mentor who can provide guidance on a regular basis. Another suggestion was to have the student work with a more senior group co-leader (postdoc or staff/faculty) so that early career scientists at other career stage can be included.
