IV. Open Issues:

- a) Harvey Weinstein article in NY Times:
 - i. Bob Lincoln an overview of events that led to discussion with Doon Gibbs, Jack Anderson, Tom Schlagel, Wen Hu and Anna Goldberg. Tom Schlagel gave an overview of what happened at the Science Council meeting where the issue was originally brought up.
 - ii. Bob Lincoln mentioned to be careful about communications to make sure not to misinterpret others. If something is does not sounds right, ask to clarify. To voice concerns, contact George Goode (Employee Concerns Program) and/or HR.
 - iii. Bob plans on publishing data on disciplinary actions at BNL for the past few years. This includes termination for inappropriate behavior (2 in the recent years), suspensions, and written warnings. Most BNL investigations address disrespectful workplace environment. Bob offered to present the data to BWIS prior to publication.
