JUST SAY: "I'M SORRY"

"Wow, I just heard what I said. I apologize." OR "I didn't introduce you properly, I'm sorry." OR "I ignored you in the meeting, I'm sorry."

DON'T SAY:

"Sorry I offended you; that wasn't my intent." OR "Sorry, it was just a joke!"

DON'T MINIMIZE THE ACT – APOLOGIZE.

Follow up with an additional apology if it seems appropriate.
