

Suspect-Counterfeit Items

- Problem has existed for more than 10 years
- DOE Occurrence Reports are required
- SBMS SA "Suspect/Counterfeit Items"
Staff contacts the S/C Item Coordinator
- SBMS S/C Item Program Description
- Numerous bolts have been found at BNL
- Other types of S/C items exist, including electrical, plumbing, and mechanical
- Latest problem is substitution

Suspect Bolts in Truck Tie-Downs

- Information from DOE QAWG sent to QRs in 11/01.
- Plant Engineering found 2 old tie-downs in 01/02.
- QRs were notified again when suspect tie-downs were found at BNL.
- Occurrence Report issued because tie downs could have been used for transporting hazardous waste.
- Approximately 20 additional tie-downs have been found at Central Shops, Collider-Accelerator, and Magnet Division. Some in new tie-downs.
