FY08 Current Injury Performance

- DOE TRC and DART Goals for FY08 are:
 - TRC – no more than 16 cases
 - DART – no more than 6 cases
- Current Performance:
 - TRC – 10 cases
 - DART – 5 cases

Summary of DART Cases

- A contractor employee was crossing the street when he stepped into a hole in the road and twisted his ankle. (47 days away)
- An employee slipped and fell backwards during a required training drill. The fall resulted in lower back trauma. (11 days away, 15 restricted days)
- An employee fell when exiting a box truck. He struck his shoulder, hip and head on the ground. He received medical treatment at the emergency room. (20 days away)

Summary of DART Cases

- An employee went to the OMC and reported suffering numbness in her arm after moving a metal cart out of a storage closet. The employee received prescription medication and lost one work day, making this a recordable injury and a DART case. (1 day away)
- An employee fell, injured his head, and was transported off-site by ambulance. (4 days away)
