Free Prostate Cancer Screening

This free prostate cancer screening includes a PSA blood test and a digital rectal examination. Screenings will be performed by Howard Adler, M.D., assistant professor of clinical urology and director of the Stony Brook University Hospital's Prostate Care Program.

According to the American Cancer Society both prostate-specific antigen (PSA) testing and digital rectal examination (DRE) are recommended annually, beginning at age 50 years. Men at high risk should begin testing at age 45 years. Men at even higher risk, due to multiple first-degree relatives (father, son or brother) affected at an early age, could begin testing at age 40.
