GOVERNMENT SUPPLY SOURCES**

In accordance with Federal Acquisition Regulation Part 51, Use of Government Sources by Contractors, you or your designee, are hereby authorized to use the master Department of Energy (DOE) Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (ID/IQ) contracts, such as contract DE-AM01-95AD35199 with CSS Laboratories, DE-AM01-94AD34195 with Dulles Networking Associates, and other contracts currently listed on the Internet at the following address: <http://www.hr.doe.gov/dimap> and those that may be added in the future. In addition to the ID/IQ contracts listed there are other DOE wide contracts that have been issued by other M&O contractors. BNL may make use of those contracts on an as needed basis.

Effective immediately, and continuing until the expiration of your contract on November 16, 2002, you are authorized to place orders directly with the contractors identified at the Internet address cited above. All such orders are subject to the requirements and limitations of your contract, the Delivery Order Authorization clause of the contract under which the order is being placed and the following administrative restrictions:

1. Prior to placing an order with any of the ID/IQ contractors listed, authorization numbers are to be obtained from the either of the following persons:

2. As contracts are added other individuals may be identified from which authorization numbers must be obtained prior to placement of any order.
