

**THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL GOVERN THE USE OF THE
LABORATORY CAMPSITE WHILE BEING USED BY
THE BNL FAMILY CAMPING CLUB**

1. ALL CAMPERS USING AREA MUST BE CLUB MEMBERS OR GUESTS
2. GUESTS (One Guest): An employee is allowed to bring one guest per visit without special permission or prior arrangement. The employee must accompany the guest.
(Two to Five Guests): Advance arrangement for two to five guests may be made at the Recreation Office. (No more than five guests per employee are ever permitted). When such arrangement is made, the Recreation Office issues an admission card stating the sponsor's name and life number, the number of guests permitted, the date of visit, and facility to be visited. The employee, whom will be requested to show the admission card at the main gate, must accompany guests. Sponsoring employees are responsible for their guests during the entire time they are on site.
3. All campsites are on a first come-first serve basis. No reservations allowed.
4. A minimum of two BNL Camping Club member families will be necessary to use the campsite. One of the BNL Club members present must assume responsibility for area and persons involved, and notify one member of executive board 48 hours in advance.
5. Pets will be permitted but must be kept on a leash near site of immediate owner. A leash is to be no longer than six (6) feet in length. Owner will be responsible for their behavior and clean up. Pets are not to run loose in immediate camping area. Owner must be able to furnish proof of currently effective inoculation of pet, to club secretary, if necessary.
6. There will be no open fires in the grove - either on the ground or in any type of container except designated fire place.
7. All charcoal fires will be started outside the grove. No charcoal fires to be left unattended. Hot charcoal will be extinguished before being dumped into fireplace.
8. Every precaution should be taken at all times to prevent fires and accidents.
9. Gym facilities and pool, when open, can be used by children and guests - only under supervision of a BNL Camping Club adult member.
10. Children and visitors will not be permitted outside camping area unless accompanied by an adult club member. All buildings except gym and cafeteria are off limits.
11. All cars will be parked on grove side of road or as directed by person in charge.

12. Trees and shrubs are not to be cut or damaged.
13. Bicycling and hiking is permitted on unrestricted thoroughfares. Caution should be taken of archery range south of camping area.
14. Camping area will be thoroughly policed before leaving.
