

Hilary Warmoth – Biography

Hilary is an international citizen. Born in Nairobi, Kenya to military parents and educated in France, she has moved home 25 times, attended eight schools and lived in seven countries. The only constants in this ever changing world have been Hilary's family, including her husband of 32 years Tim. His flexibility and adaptable character have seen them both through some testing times.

As a young mother Hilary was given the chance to undertake a 3 month training course for "women with unrealized management potential." It was this opportunity, which sparked a lifelong interest in Hilary for personal and career development for both herself and others. Hilary also spent ten years in economic development in the UK public sector where she also studied for her Diploma in Marketing with the Chartered Institute of Marketing, before she switched into the private sector to work with A4e Ltd. A company dedicated to improving the lives of disadvantaged people by exclusion from the labor market (such as the long term unemployed, ex offenders, homeless). Here she worked her way to General Manager of their first international operation before taking a life changing career break in 2007. This step took her to University in Birmingham and an MBA in Public Service (International Development) and finally to a career in International Development as a consultant with UNIDO in Pakistan, providing technical expertise in vocational training and entrepreneurship.

Six months ago, Hilary founded 3e Clubs, a social enterprise focused on career development for women in transition. This enterprise provides guidance and support for women; seeking work, study opportunities or volunteering experiences in a new country. Hilary also mentors women looking to move to a new role or wanting to equip themselves for promotion within their existing workplace.
