Suggestions for items they could use:

- Winter coats, hats, gloves, scarves
 - Gently used suits, ties and dress shirts (to go on an interview)
 - Sweatpants and sweatshirts, underwear, t-shirts, jeans, white athletic socks, sneakers
 - Paper products – paper plates, paper cups, napkins, toilet paper, paper towels
 - Wind up alarm clocks, lamps
 - Men’s socks, Underwear, t-shirts (new please!)
 - Canned goods and non-perishable foods
 - Razors, Shaving soap, Toothbrushes, Toothpaste, Shampoo, Soap
 - Books: Self Help/Motivational Books, Health/Diet Books, cookbooks
 - Blankets, pillows, towels, washcloths
 - Twin size: Sheets, Pillow cases, Blankets, Pillows, Mattress covers
- Arrangements can be made for these large items to be picked up at a later date:**
- Microwave Oven (heavy duty), refrigerator/freezer/stove, TV sets,
 - DVD or VCR’s, dressers & nightstands
