FIRST SUMMER CONCERT

JOHN LANGSTAFF

The first event in the 1952 summer concert series will be a recital by the young American baritone, John Langstaff on Wednesday, July 30, in the Research Staff Lounge. His program will include a group of French songs of the 13th to 16th centuries; lieder by Schubert and Brahms; contemporary American songs; old American songs arranged by Aaron Copland; and a group of English and American folk songs and ballads.

Mr. Langstaff's singing in recitals and records has evoked critical comments such as: "The rich and lovely singing of Mr. Langstaff was a pleasure... He really sings, and he makes music doing it." (N. Y. Herald Tribune). "A singer of quite different genre is John Langstaff.... His is a kind of art that conceals art, and I hope that we shall have many more discs from this rare artist." (Saturday Review of Literature).
