COSMOTRON PROGRAM ON T.V. SHOW

The role of the Brookhaven Cosmotron in investigations of the particles making up the nucleus of the atom will be explained on the Johns Hopkins Science Review, Dumont Network (WABD, New York, Channel 5), 8:30 to 9:00 p.m., Monday, February 16.

Dr. George B. Collins, chairman of the Accelerator Department at Brookhaven National Laboratory, Upton, N.Y., will participate in the "live" part of the program, which originates from Baltimore. There will also be films of the Cosmotron, as well as demonstrations of the "world within the atom", and of research techniques for investigation of the nucleus and its components.
