## TALK ON "ALSOS" TO BE GIVEN BY DR. SAMUEL A. GOUDSMIT

"ALSOS was the code name for one of the strangest missions the U.S. Army ever created - a mission so secret that only the highest government officials knew of its existence. ALSOS was a brand new kind of intelligence outfit with scientists as super-sleuths."\*

The Alsos Mission was created to determine how far the Germans had advanced in nuclear science during World War II. This information was desperately needed by our military people.

Hear this story from the leader of the Alsos Mission - Dr. Samuel A. Goudsmit - Chairman of B.N.L.'s Physics Dept. The talk will take place on Wednesday, July 15, at 7:30 P.M. in the Research Staff Lounge.
