The theatre group joins with the concert group in sponsoring a modern dance program November 24 in the theatre. The company, led by Donald McKayle, includes nine dancers and four musicians. They will present three major works: Mr. McKayle's ballet "Games", "Nocturne", and an entirely new work, "The Street", which will be seen by an audience for the first time here in our theatre.

This is going to be a highly interesting and original program, both musically and theatrically. The dance company includes a set designer and will bring along the scenery and props for a full scale production. A number of theatre group members will assist technically in the lighting and staging of the show. It's going to be the major event of the fall season here on the Lab site, so don't miss it. Tickets will be on sale in all departments for those who do not hold season concert tickets.

THEATRE GROUP WORKSHOP

The theatre group workshop under the direction of Tom Turner of the Sayville Musical Workshop will hold its fifth meeting next Tuesday evening. At the usual time and place: at 8 on stage at the theatre here on the site. The workshop has proved so interesting and instructive that the participants have voted to remove the ten week limit. The workshop now plans to continue through till late spring, with an interruption in early spring for the next theatre group production. The extension allows a more intensive study and participation than the survey approach originally planned. The emphasis thus far is on acting and direction, but technical phases will be included as they arise later on in the staging of some scenes. It is not too late to join this group.
