ATOMIC ENERGY TREATMENT OF BRAIN TUMOR
TO BE DESCRIBED ON TELEVISION DEC.19

The use of an atomic pile in treatment of brain tumor will be described by Dr. Lee E. Farr of Bellport, chairman of the Medical Department, Brookhaven National Laboratory, as part of the Johns Hopkins Science Review, 1-1:30 p.m. Sunday, December 19, Dumont Television Network, WABD, New York, Channel 5. The program is the second in a series entitled "The Peaceful Atom", with Dr. John C. Bugher, Director, Division of Biology and Medicine, U.S. Atomic Energy Commission, presenting applications of radioisotopes in treatment of various diseases.
