THIRD CONCERT OF B.E.R.A. SERIES

Theresa Green, Soprano

Wednesday, February 9, 1955 - 8:30 P.M. - Research Staff Lounge

B.E.R.A. is pleased to present Theresa Green, soprano, in the third concert of the season on February 9. Miss Green studied from early childhood in her home town of Baltimore, then in New York with Mme. Eva Gauthier and in Philadelphia at the Curtis Institute of Music where she graduated in 1950.

Many honors have been awarded her. In addition to a scholarship at the Curtis Institute she has won the Marian Anderson Award, a John Hay Whitney Fellowship, and the annual award of JUGGS, a foundation for the advancement of outstanding young musical talent. As a result of winning on the Arthur Godfrey Talent Scout TV program, she was presented three times by Mr. Godfrey. Her Community Concert performances have been sold out consistently for the past few years.

In a review of one of Theresa Green's concerts the Herald Tribune wrote, "A gifted young singer with an appealing presence and a delicacy of temperament. The innate beauty of her voice, as well as her ability to perform clearly and musically, would seem to indicate that further awards are in store for her in the concert and open field. Her good looks, too, will no doubt help along".

Miss Green's program includes songs by Brahms, Schumann, Strauss, Schubert, Handel, four American composers, and many others. Single admissions will be sold at \$1.75 for adults and \$.75 for students on the night of the concert.

The B.E.R.A. Concert Committee wishes to announce that two changes have been made in the fifth and final concert of the season. The date has been changed from April 7 to Wednesday, April 6 and instead of the WQXR String Quartet we will have Leonid Hambro, pianist, together with three members of the WQXR String Quartet in a program of piano quartets and trios.
