Several seasons ago Dimitri Mitropoulos formed the New York Chamber Ensemble comprised of selected artists of the New York Philharmonic Symphony. They have since given many successful concerts in the city working in various combinations ranging from violin solos to double string octets.

For their Brookhaven concert on Friday, April 13, five members of the Ensemble will be present. They are Leon Temerson and Leon Rudin, violinists; David Kates, violist; Heinrich Joachim, cellist; and Stanley Drucker, clarinetist. Their program will be as follows:

Stanley Drucker is a brilliant 26 year-old clarinetist who at 19 was the youngest member ever to have been taken into the Philharmonic. His performances of the two quintets will certainly be enjoyed by all.
