THE BILLY TAYLOR TRIO

JULY FIRST

The concert performance of the Billy Taylor Trio promises to furnish an exciting and enjoyable experience to all listeners, short and long-hairs alike. Those not *au courant* in the jazz idiom should find in Mr. Taylor's music and exposition a new source of interest and pleasure. To the *aficionado*, the Billy Taylor Trio needs no introduction.

Mr. Taylor's art is in the great jazz piano tradition; he blends the modern jazz vocabulary with the traditional jazz spirit. His music shows its strength in grace and economy, and it displays Taylor's gifts for melody and line.

Before forming his trio five years ago, Mr. Taylor played with groups which included Dizzy Gillespie, Charlie Parker, J.J. Johnson, and other stars of the jazz galaxy. He and his trio have toured Europe, promoting interest in contemporary American music. Mr. Taylor has lectured and concertized in this country at institutions such as Hunter College, NYU, Columbia, Town Hall, the Copa Cabana, and Birdland.
