

Sign Up & Share a Ride

When you save yourself hassle by getting your digitized driver's license photo taken on site next week (see story at right), you'll also be able to sign up for a car pool or van pool that will save you commuting hassle. At each photo location, the BNL Carpool/Vanpool Program — the same folks who brought you last February's survey on commuting habits and attitudes — will have registration forms for the computerized ride-matching service that will begin serving BNLers this fall. Complete the form when you get your photo taken, or return it to Jeff Williams, Bldg. 535A, and get your car pool or van pool rolling, or expand your existing one. If you're already part of a car pool or van pool, be sure to fill out a form — you will be eligible for certain benefits to be announced this fall and available only to car poolers and van poolers.

Don't Like Your Driver's License Photo? Get a New, Digital One at BNL Next Week

One of life's little hassles is going to get your driver's license renewed. There's usually a line, and a wait, and then you have to face . . . *the camera*. And Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) offices aren't exactly portrait studios.

Well, okay, neither is the lobby of Berkner Hall, nor the lobby or lounge of other buildings on site. But, from Monday through Wednesday, September 12 to 14, BNLers will be able to get a new driver's license photo taken at any of these locations, when the New York Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) brings its portable digital cameras to BNL as part of the DMV's "Early Bird" imaging effort.

Even if your present, old-style photo license is valid for several years to come, you can have the photo taken for the new, digitized New York license now and avoid having to make the trek to a DMV office later. Then, when your license is about to expire, the DMV will send an invitation to renew it by mail. The same goes for replacements for lost or stolen licenses: Because the photo is stored on a computer, it can be reproduced at any time.

Of course, if you already have a digitized photo in your

license (you can tell because there's a black magnetic strip on the back and a nine-digit ID number on the front), you're all set and don't need to have it taken again.

There is no fee for having the photo taken, although the normal license fee will apply when the license is renewed. The DMV representatives will also administer simple eye exams at the time of the photo, and will need to see current photo licenses or non-driver ID cards.

Both of the two-person photographic teams will set up their high-tech cameras in various locations around the site; a complete schedule has been sent to all employees. If you can't make it to the time and date set aside for your department or division, walk-ins by on-site personnel, including guests, will also be taken in Berkner Hall on Wednesday from 7 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and in the Brookhaven Center from 11:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. No appointments are necessary in any location.

So save yourself some time and frustration — and get a better driver's license photo of yourself in the bargain. For more information, call Bob Kelly, Personnel Division, Ext. 3782.


