FILM STUDY GROUP PROGRAM FOR MONDAY, JANUARY 10

To supplement the Film Study Groups feature film, a series of three short films will be presented from the library of Film Images, Inc. The first of these, entitled "A Matter of Time" will precede the showing of the "Promoter" on Monday, January 10. This program will begin promptly at 8:20.

"A Matter of Time" is a documentary film about the trials and tribulations of a French barge captain. Directed and photographed by Victor Vicas, with music by Claude Aprieu, the film abounds in splendid images recording with a sensitive eye of a poet the true-to-life drama of an ordinary French citizen. As we follow intently the problems faced by the barge skipper and his family in taking a cargo to Belgium, we see a bit of everyday French life set in a beautifully composed, moving panorama of French country and cityscapes. An engrossing and lovely glimpse of a way of life in France.

Star billing for the evening in "The Promoter" goes to Alec Guinness who plays the part of an ingenious, young, lovable rogue who through a series of remarkable maneuvers promotes his election to Mayor of the town. The supporting cast includes Glynis Johns, Valerie Hobson, and Petula Clark.
