

LECTURE ON OPERATIONS RESEARCH

Dr. William J. Horvath will present a lecture on Operations Research, Wednesday May 11, at 7:30 P.M. in the Lecture Hall. All B.N.L. employees are invited to attend this open meeting of the Naval Research Reserve.

The field of Operations Research is an application of elementary mathematical analysis to problems of "operations", whether they be military or industrial. This field grew up originally during the war when a group of physicists, mathematicians, actuaries, chess players and others applied themselves to an analysis of anti-submarine operations. Dr. Horvath was associated with this -group headed by Prof. P. M. Morse from its early days. He continued with this work until its scope expanded and he became Deputy Director of the "Weapons Systems Evaluation Group" for the Joint Chiefs of Staff in 1949. He is now a consultant in the field of Operations Research.

Dr. Horvath received his PhD in Nuclear Physics in 1940. He received the Naval Ordnance Development Award in 1945, and the Presidential Certificate of Merit in 1947. In 1954, he served as Vice-President of the Operations Research Society of America,
