THE LAST LAUGH

July 11

Now released in 16 mm. with a musical score added. The Last Laugh features Emil Jannings who plays a magnificent head porter of a continental hotel who stands resplendent in his gold braided uniform and grandiosely superintends the handling of the guests' luggage. By his uniform he exists, for him it is the symbol of his authority and of his spiritual well-being. One day he comes to work to find that another, younger man has his job and his uniform, and he in his old age has been relegated the job of lavatory attendant.

Under F.W. Murnau's direction and Carl Freund's dramatic use of the movie camera, a remarkable psychological tension is created, beautifully dramatizing a state of mind as well as a state of society. Produced in Germany in 1924.

DIARY OF A COUNTRY PRIEST

July 18

Directed by Robert Bresson and based on a novel by Georges Bernanos, this film features Claude Laydu and Nicole Maurey. Awarded the Venice Film Festival Special Award, 1951, the picture was admired and honored for its profound subject matter, artistic direction, and beautifuly cinematography. A film of faith — about a French priest's attempt to raise the moral level of his village, his outer and inner conflicts and anguish, and the townspeople's misinterpretation of his temperament and faith.

MISS JULIE

July 25

Based on Strindberg's psychological drama of passion, this film is truly "mid-summer eve" magic as it shuttles between the peasant celebration and the aristocratic household involvements in one night of 1888 in Sweden. Magnificently acted by the Swedish star, Anita Bjork.
