The Vegh String Quartet

Wed. Oct. 19, Research Staff Lounge, 8:30 P.M.

In 1940 the Vegh String Quartet had its debut in Budapest, Hungary, a city which has given the world some of the greatest string players and string ensembles of all time. The Vegh is one of the few quartets whose member have remained the same from the beginning. Their reputation had already been well established in Europe by 1946 when they were awarded first prize as "the finest quartet" during the post-war International Music Competition held in Geneva that year.

The popularity of the Vegh Quartet in the United States has grown very rapidly during the past few years and they arrive in New York on Oct. 15 for their third tour of this country. At their Brookhaven concert the Vegh Quartet will present the following program:

 Quartet in F Minor, Op. 95 (serioso)....Beethoven
