BERA'S FILM FOR THE MONTH IS "HIGH AND DRY"

On Monday, January 9th at 8:30 P.M. the British Universal International film will be shown in the Lecture Hall. Admission 50¢. The movie, produced at Michael Balcon's Ealing Studio, shows it is more than coincidence that the men who direct these pictures have invariably had experience in the remarkable school of British documentary production. No small part of their success in comedy stems from their method of building up a sense of milieu through a documentary kind of reportage before they throw the switch and play it for laughs. The laughs come once the backgrounds have been established and the eccentricities of the prinicipals begin to emerge against them. It is a formula that has worked admirably in the past. It still works in "High and Dry," Alexander Mackendrick's latest film.

Scotland's "puffer boats," tiny cargo vessels, furnish the background for this one. The Maggie is ancient, decrepit, and operated by a contankerous skipper who wangles a cargo under false--and decidedly humorous pretenses. The cargo belongs to a high-pressure American businessman (Paul Douglas) who can't understand how it got on Maggie in the first place, but is so determined to see it doesn't stay there that he goes aboard the ship himself. Most of the film is concerned with the wily Scot's successful efforts to frustrate the American, and much of it is ingenious and amusing--Maggie getting hung up on the Glasgow subway, the skipper contriving to have Douglas's very respectable agent arrested for poaching, his canny outguessing of Douglas at every turn.
