An Incomplete Education is a story of Victorian newlyweds, well brought up and fully prepared for any eventuality except that of marriage. They are enlightened by the arrival of a thunderstorm and its resulting incidents.

The work by Milhaud consists of two Greek myths treated in half-comic half-serious style and modernized to point up analogies of our times with those of ancient Greece.

Performing the Mozart piano quartet will be John Colman, piano, Dorothy Minty, violin, Clifford Richter, viola and Laverne Tuttle, cello.

Admission will be \$1.75 for adults & \$.75 for children, or by subscription ticket.
