## BERA CONCERT

PAUL DOKTOR, Viola .. accompanied by

In their recital on November 14, Mr. Doktor and Miss Chinn will perform works by Schubert, Brahms, Milhaud and Caix d'Hervelois.

Paul Doktor began his career as a violinist with the chamber orchestra of Adolph Busch, but concentrated his efforts on the viola after playing this instrument with the Busch Quartet, in which group his father, Karl Doktor, was the violist. Mr. Doktor was awarded first prize at the International Music Competition in Geneva in 1942, and in 1948 he made his American debut.

In addition to performing in Europe and America, Paul Doktor teaches at the Mannes School of Music in New York. Music critics have lauded Mr. Doktor's artistry with such statements as:

"Doktor's mastery was apparent at every point in the program. He is an artist of the highest attainments, lacking nothing that produces the finest kind of musical entity." -Washington Post
