The Juilliard Quartet has performed here in the past before enthusiastic audiences. This quartet was founded in 1946 at the Juilliard School of Music, where the members of the quartet teach chamber music. They are particularly noted for their performances of contemporary music and have recorded compositions by Bartok, Schoenberg, Berg, and contemporary American composers. However, their interest in the modern repertoire is not at the expense of the more classic quartets. This fact was well demonstrated during their five-month-tour of Europe in 1955, which brought forth such praise as:

"They played Beethoven with unforgettable splendor, Hayden with miraculous lightness and grace." -Salzburg Festival

"It seems as if the quiescence of the classical European tradition returns to us from America." -Munich

"Here in the Mozart Quartet as performed by these venerable interpreters is the art of chamber music at its finest and highest." -Basle

Their concert here will consist of the Mozart Quartet in G major, K. 387; the Beethoven Quartet in F major, Opus 135; and the Bartok Fifth Quartet (1934).

As usual, those who do not have season tickets may purchase tickets at the door. The price is \$1.75 for adults and \$.50 for children.
