III. Report on BWIS activities:

a) Director of Membership:

- i. Membership numbers: No new members in June. We had 4 or 5 new members in May.
- ii. Treasurer's report: 7k allocated out of the 13k
 - 1. High School Career day hasn't hit the budget yet.
 - a. The bus/transportation cost was \$983.74.
 - 2. Estimated costs for Goldhaber Award are \$1429, \$500 for the reception food and beverages, and \$650 for the reception and supplies.
 - 3. There is a BSA lecture coming up, and there will be a few more speakers this fiscal year. We will need the standard coffee and refreshment order.
 - 4. Once we have the July statement from BSA, we can plan for spending in August and September.
 - 5. If we wanted to allocate this year's funds for an event in early October, we could ask to specifically accrue funds for that reception.
 - 6. We can spend money on USB sticks for new members.
 - 7. Monthly statements are uploaded to the BWIS network drive.
 - 8. Mengen is leaving BNL (she graduated yay!). She will return check books and credit card statements to BWIS.
