 - b. Single day/week for each ERG to present their awards (rather than scattered over multiple days throughout the year).
 - c. Have Chasman and Goldhaber award presentations during NSLS2 and RHIC user meetings to coincide the award with its history. The Fowler award is already set as a Chemistry Division seminar.
