



#### **BNL Site – Historical Overview**

- ➤ Pre–1900: Pine-Oak forest
  - Transient Native American activity
  - Local cordwood industry
- ➤ 1917–1921: World War I Camp Upton
  - Induction & Training Camp
- ➤ 1930s: Civilian Conservation Corps
  - Upton National Forest
- ➤ 1940–1946: World War II Camp Upton
  - Induction Center, then Convalescence & Rehabilitation
- ➤ 1947-present: Brookhaven National Laboratory
  - Large science facilities (reactors, accelerators, etc.)




## Hulse Map 1742 - 1797




