A Cost-Free Expert (CFE) is an individual who has a specialized skill that is not readily available among the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) professional staff and who works on a defined task that cannot be financed under the current IAEA budget. Such tasks are usually performed for the support divisions of the Department of Safeguards.

The U.S. Support Program (USSP) provides funding to the IAEA for the cost of CFEs. The recruitment and administration of the program in the IAEA's Dept. of Safeguards is coordinated by the International Safeguards Project Office at Brookhaven National Laboratory.
