If the scope of work changes, new materials or processes are added, or new information dictates that we revise the JHA/SWP and other BNL permits and notification, we will provide BNL with the revised document(s) for review and approval prior to further work.

I acknowledge that BNL will obtain appropriate permits required by regulatory agencies. We will always abide by the requirements of the permit.

I am aware of, have read, understand, and ensure that our company will comply with the environmental, safety and health requirements and regulations cited in each section of the HASP as it applies to work being performed under this contract.

I understand that BNL will not tolerate non-adherence to safety requirements in the HASP and the BSA Contract Terms and Conditions. Failure to comply with any requirement will result in BNL's stopping work and may result in the barring of the violating individuals from the BNL site. Repeated safety violations may result in Termination of the Contract for Default.
