



Briefing Outline and Training Waiver for Person Under Escort

NSLS-II Building 740 Controlled Area Access / Radiological Training Waiver

The training requirements to enter into Controlled Area Bldg 740, an area controlled for radiological purpose, have been waived because the individual meets the requirements of this procedure and are under the escort(s) identified below

Briefing Outline: Visitors MUST:

- Remain within sight of a qualified Escort at all times
- Communicate in the same language as the Escort
- Follow the directions of the escort should an emergency arise, since the escort is responsible for the person under escort
- Maximum 10 visitors per Escort
- Be aware of the hazards of the area:
 - There may be locally posted hazards such as magnetic fields, lasers, gas systems, construction areas, and material handling
 - Beware of material handling activities, electric vehicles and tricycle riders – look both ways
 - Enclosed shoes are required throughout the facility
 - Long pants/long skirts are required beyond the outside tour/safety corridor marked with a white painted line
- The person under escort may not do any work or touch any item that may degrade radiological conditions. The escort needs to identify such items to the escorted person
- Certain areas may require a radiological monitoring device (TLD) . Do not enter those areas unless you are wearing a TLD or are part of a group with a group TLD.
- NOT disturb apparatus or installed components
